## Upgrading the Pacific Highway Brunswick Heads to Yelgun

*This project is jointly funded by the Australian and New South Wales governments*

### Progress Update No. 7

Earthworks, drainage, retaining walls, bridge construction, concrete paving, landscaping and fencing (including fauna fencing) are proceeding. Construction of the Yelgun Rest Area and the Billinudgel Pedestrian Bridge continues.

In addition, the following activities are scheduled or have taken place:

#### December

- Bridgeworks at Marshalls Creek and Marshalls Creek Overflow.
- Traffic switch to the local access road over Brunswick River.
- Final stitch pour for the northbound Pacific Highway bridge over the Brunswick River.
- Construction of Brunswick River southbound bridge deck.

#### January

- Construction of Brunswick River southbound bridge deck.
- Construction of the new connection to Riverside Crescent.
- Commencement of constructed wetland at Billinudgel Pedestrian Bridge, Balemo Drive.

#### February

- Construction of Brunswick River southbound bridge deck.
- Demolition of the old Brunswick River bridge commences.
- Changed intersection arrangements at Orana Road with the opening of the new connection to Coolamon Scenic Drive and the temporary installation of traffic signals.
