



## Upgrading the Pacific Highway **Brunswick Heads to Yelgun**

*This project is jointly funded by the Australian and New South Wales governments*

### **Last Progress Update**

The following activities are scheduled throughout the following three months:

#### **July – September 2007**

- Official opening and community event 8 July 2007.
- Pacific Highway traffic switched to the completed upgrade on 11 July 2007 and local traffic remains on the local service road – Brunswick Valley Way.
- Finishing works including installation of signposting, traffic barriers, street lighting, linemarking and miscellaneous road furniture.
- Completion of Brunswick River timber boardwalk, and shared paths.
- Opening of Billinudgel pedestrian bridge.
- Adjustments to existing traffic arrangements at the northern and southern ends of the upgrade including the Brunswick Heads bypass.
- Demolition and removal of the old Brunswick River bridge completed.
- Removal of the Ferry Reserve Caravan Park noise wall.
- Final asphalt pavement works on Brunswick Valley Way.
- Completion of Yelgun rest area works.
- Diversion of local traffic at Orana Road to allow construction of the new Orana Road roundabout.
- Construction of roundabouts at Rajah Road, Orana Road and completion of the new roundabout at Brunswick Heads Road.
- 'Urban edge' landscape planting continues.
- Opening of new Coolamon Scenic Drive underpass.
- Dismantling and removal of site construction compound facilities.

Abigroup Contractors Pty Ltd have been contracted to maintain the construction corridor for 10 years.

Following completion of all works, the project website (refer to the link below) will remain in operation for 12 months. Operational noise monitoring will be undertaken within 6 months of opening of the upgrade.
