### **Project opening**

Works are almost complete on the Brunswick Heads to Yelgun Pacific Highway upgrade project. Traffic will be switched on to the upgraded highway on Wednesday 11 July 2007. To celebrate the opening of the project a community event will take place on **Sunday 8 July 2007**.

Activities will commence from 10am with jumping castles, free face painting, souvenir T-shirts, free entertainment - stilt walkers and clowns, a live band, food stalls, car displays, school colouring in competition, RTA and community displays.
