Changed Traffic Arrangements

Pacific Highway - Brunswick River to Rajah Road

The Roads and Traffic Authority and Abigroup Contractors Pty Ltd advise of upcoming changes to traffic arrangements on the Pacific Highway **between the Brunswick River and Rajah Road intersection at Ocean Shores**. This is part of the works for the Brunswick Heads to Yelgun Pacific Highway upgrade.

On **Tuesday 16 May 2006**, (weather permitting) traffic will be diverted onto a temporary re-alignment of the Pacific Highway immediately north of the Brunswick River Bridge.

Access to Rajah Road and the Brunswick Heads Nature Reserve will be maintained via new intersection arrangements. All existing movements will be maintained at all times though-out the works. Directional signposting and a 60km/hr speed limit will assist road users in this area.

Motorists are advised to travel through the new works with care and observe any directions given by traffic controllers.
