TRAFFIC ALERT FOR PACIFIC HIGHWAY AT BRUNSWICK HEADS

Motorists are advised of a changed speed limit on the Pacific Highway at Brunswick Heads as work continues on the Pacific Highway upgrade.

The speed limit will be reduced to 40kmh from 300m north of the Rajah Road intersection to 300m south of the Rajah Road intersection.

The temporary reduction in speed limit has been put in place for the safety of all road users and construction workers on the site.

The reduced speed limit will be clearly signposted. Variable message boards and courtesy speed check boards will also be put in place.

Motorists are requested to take care when driving through the works and obey any temporary traffic controls, signage or directions given by Traffic Controllers.

Motorists are reminded that construction speed limits are enforceable by the Police. This reduction in speed will be in place until the service road bridge is open in approximately 3 to 4 months.

Access to Brunswick Heads Nature Reserve Road will be maintained.
