The Roads and Traffic Authority (RTA) is currently upgrading the Pacific Highway between Brunswick Heads and Yelgun.

Abigroup Contractors Pty Ltd has been contracted by the RTA to design, construct and maintain the Brunswick Heads to Yelgun Upgrade for 10 years. Construction is about to commence on 8.6 kilometres of dual carriageway between the Brunswick Heads south interchange and the southern end of the Yelgun to Chinderah Freeway.

Nominations are invited from members of community groups and business representatives living near the Brunswick Heads to Yelgun project to fill vacancies in the existing community liaison group (CLG). Current CLG members need not re-apply and will be advised of the first meeting date.

The group will provide a forum for stakeholders to have input into various aspects of the two-year detailed design and construction of the project. The group will discuss ways to minimise the impacts of this project on the local community, businesses and the environment. Representatives will be selected to ensure that the group incorporates the widest possible range of interests.
