## Upgrading the Pacific Highway **Brunswick Heads to Yelgun**

*This project is jointly funded by the Australian and New South Wales governments*

### **Construction activities**

Earthworks, drainage, relocation of services and utilities, retaining walls and bridgeworks are proceeding along the entire length of the Brunswick Heads to Yelgun upgrade. The following construction works are anticipated, weather permitting, or have been recently completed:

#### **January**

- Construction on Brunswick River service road bridge abutments and piers continued.
- Traffic switch onto temporary re-alignment of Brunswick Heads bypass occurred.
- Bridge foundation works at sewerage treatment plant access commenced.

#### **February**

- Clearing for new Riverside Crescent connection and the Billinudgel pedestrian bridge commence.
- Completion of bulk earthworks.
- Completion of Rajah Road noise wall.
- Brunswick River service road bridge superstructure commences and abutment works continue, with some night works.
- Bridgeworks continue at sewerage treatment plant access and commence at Bonanza Drive.
- Construction of Tweed Street roundabout and the new link to Riverside Crescent commences.

#### **March**

- Construction on Brunswick River service road superstructure continues.
- Commencement of bridge foundation works at Yelgun interchange, Brunswick Heads Bypass and Coolamon Scenic Drive overpass.
- Commencement of bridge girder erection at Marshalls Creek and Marshalls Creek Overflow.
