Upgrading the Pacific Highway Brunswick Heads to Yelgun

This project is jointly funded by the Australian and New South Wales governments

Progress Update No. 5

Earthworks and relocation of services and utilities are proceeding along the entire length of the Brunswick Heads to Yelgun upgrade. Construction of the Yelgun Rest Area is also continuing. Settlement of earthworks along the Brunswick Heads bypass, at the Brunswick River and Marshalls Creek is almost complete.

Weather permitting, the following activities will occur over the next 3 months.

June

- Construction of Brunswick River bridge abutments and decks.
- Construction of surface drainage and road carriageway earthworks along the entire alignment.
- Construction of bridges at 13 locations.
- Construction of the Tweed Street and Yelgun roundabouts.
- Construction of retaining wall along Brunswick Heads bypass and north of the Brunswick River.
- Commencement of construction of Rajah Road roundabout.

July

- Continuing Brunswick River bridge abutments and deck construction.
- Continuing bridgeworks, particularly deck and finishings.
- Erection of bridge deck super 'T' girders above Tweed Street.
- Continuing drainage works, including Balemo Drive (northern end).
- Open new connection to Stock Route Road.
- Commencement of new traffic flow (one way circuit) through Bonanza Drive Industrial Estate.
- Establishment of a temporary concrete batch plant in the Yelgun rest area location.
- Continuing construction of a retaining wall at Brunswick Heads bypass and north of the Brunswick River.

August

- Continuing construction of Brunswick River bridge superstructure.
- Continuing bridge work across 13 locations.
- Completion of surface drainage along the alignment.
- Commencement of concrete sub-base paving.
- Traffic switch on to Marshalls Creek Service Road. Bonanza Drive entrance to Billinudgel will be opened at this time.

A community information centre has been established at the site office in Brunswick Heads Road (opposite Ferry Reserve Caravan Park). Visitors are welcome Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm.
