## **Brunswick Heads to Yelgun**

Construction activities - October to December 2005

Earthworks, drainage, relocation of services and utilities, retaining walls and bridgeworks (at Brunswick River, Marshalls Creek and Marshalls Creek Overflow) are proceeding along the entire length of the Brunswick Heads to Yelgun upgrade, including the following construction works:

### **October**

- Construction of noise wall north of Rajah Road.
- Completion of piling works for the Brunswick River bridges.
- Commencement of earthworks for the Yelgun rest area.
- Traffic switch onto the new Tweed Street alignment.

### **November**

- Commencement of bridges along the Brunswick Heads Bypass duplication.
- Traffic switch onto a temporary sidetrack at the northern end of the Brunswick Heads Bypass.

### **December**

- Pier head construction on Brunswick River bridges commences.
- Construction of retaining walls adjacent to Billinudgel.
- Super 'T' girder erection at Marshall Creek and Marshalls Creek Overflow.

A community information centre has been established at the main site office in Brunswick Heads Road (opposite Ferry Reserve Caravan Park).
