**NAVIGATION WARNING**

**BRUNSWICK RIVER – Downstream of Pacific Highway Bridge  
Navigation Hazard Warning**

Masters and owners of vessels are advised of **BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS** in the **BRUNSWICK RIVER**, Brunswick Heads during the period **20 June 2005 to 1 December 2006**.

The affected area is:

The channel on the downstream side of the existing Pacific Highway road bridge for a distance of approximately one hundred (100) metres.

**SITUATION**

Yellow flashing lights are attached to the existing road bridge to indicate its position at night. The adjacent construction area will be flood lit and mariners need to consider the effect of the white light when navigating at night.

Unlit lateral marks in the form of aqua markers will be used to indicate the clear channel during the construction operations. Daytime warning signs and yellow aqua-marks will be positioned to remind mariners to minimise wash and speed and to provide channel blocked information in the construction zone.

Be aware that Clause 19 (6) (b) of the Management of Waters and Waterside Lands Regulations requires that “a vessel shall not be navigated on any navigable waters at a speed in excess of 4 knots within 100 metres from any construction or any works in progress”

**CAUTION:**

Mariners are advised to exercise caution when navigating in the above area
